

Instructions for Book Sales



I'm always happy to sign books for teachers and children during my visit. The books can be ordered directly from the publishing companies, bookstores, or from EDSTAR, INC., our office in Ogdensburg, NY, or from Edstar Canada, Inc. in Ottawa.

Please let me know if you would like me to autograph books during my visit, and where you will be obtaining the books.

The enclosed order form reflects the discounted prices on the books. If you would like to use the book sales as a fund raiser, you can sell the books at the full retail price.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR BOOK SALES

- * Make a copy of the order form (front and back) for each student.
- * Fill in the line, MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO (your school or Edstar, Inc.)
- * Send home as early as possible before the author visit.
- * Collect order forms and checks. Do not send checks through the mail as they have been lost in the past. Keep them until Kalli's visit.
- E-mail Edstar, Inc. at Edstark2@aol.com with the titles and numbers of books the children have ordered well before the visit. We will send the order to the warehouse, and the books will be shipped from New York or Ottawa. This is an example of the information we need:
